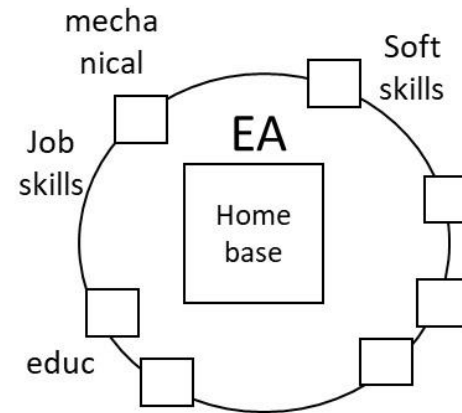

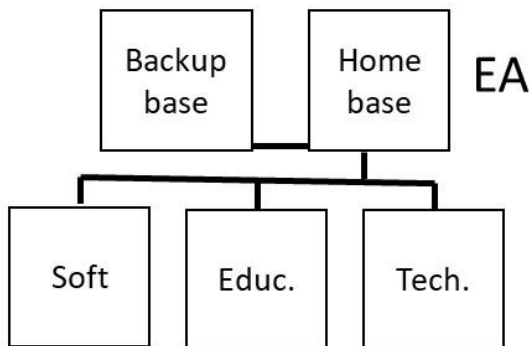

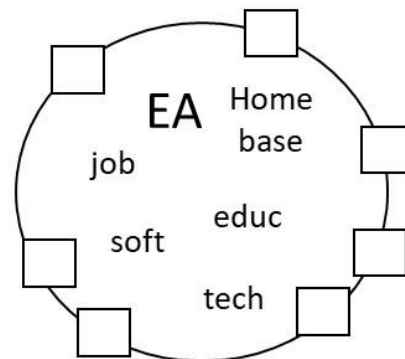
Meet with individuals



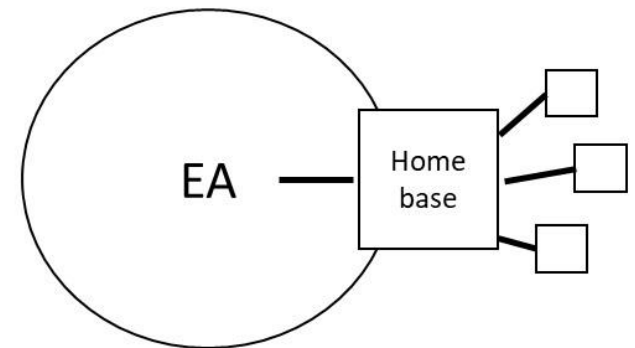

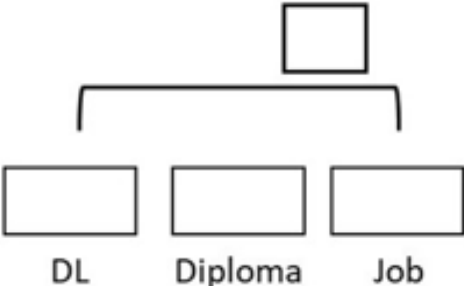

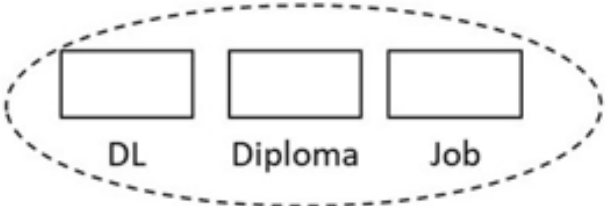


Example Divisions of Responsibilities

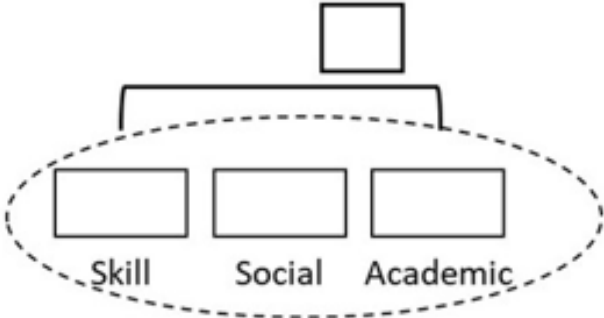
A1: Autocratic leader
Organized by goal



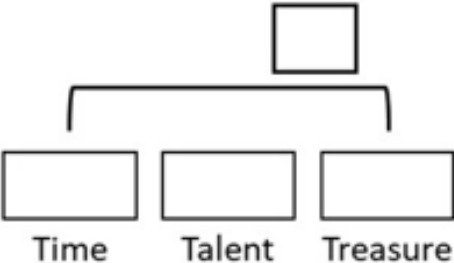
G: Group decisions
Organized by goal



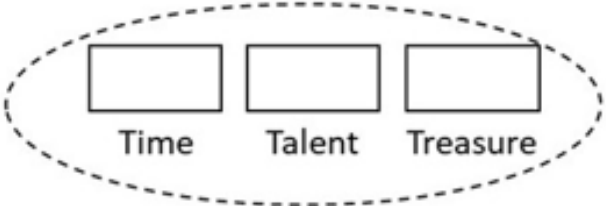
C1: Consultative leadership
Organized by specialization



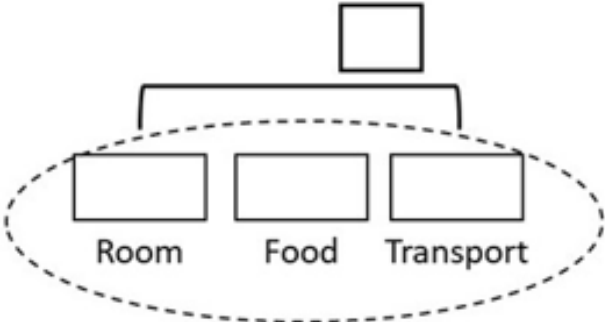
A2: Autocratic leader
